

**Footwear:**

Boots/sturdy shoes

**Clothing:**

Waterproofs during wet weather

**Toilets/Refreshments:**

Glenridding or Pooley Bridge Piers or villages, on the 'Steamers'.

**Walk A – Woodland Wander**

A short loop through mixed woodland on a small hill at the foot of Ullswater , with a possible climb to the summit. A moderate walk with some slopes, length 1.5 miles with a height climbed of 350ft. Chances to spot and hear a rich biodiversity of woodland species such as Tree Creeper, Nut Hatches, Great Tits, Sparrowhawks, Buzzard, Spotted Flycatchers, Swallows, Sand Martins, Wood Pigeons, Roe Deer, Red Squirrels, Weasels, Stoats, Greater Spotted Woodpeckers to name a few.

**Walk B – River Ramble**

A gentle stroll along the bank of the River Eamont, this walk is approx a mile in length. An easy, level walk along the shore, chances to see some of our wetland birds along the way and at the end of the walk is a fantastic opportunity to get some of those shots on the pond,. Currently we have a breeding pair of mute swans, other birds to watch out for are Mallards, Goosanders, Kestrels, Pied Wagtails, Grey Wagtails, Dippers, Moorhens, Kingfisher, Fly Catchers, a rich biodiversity of species on display.
