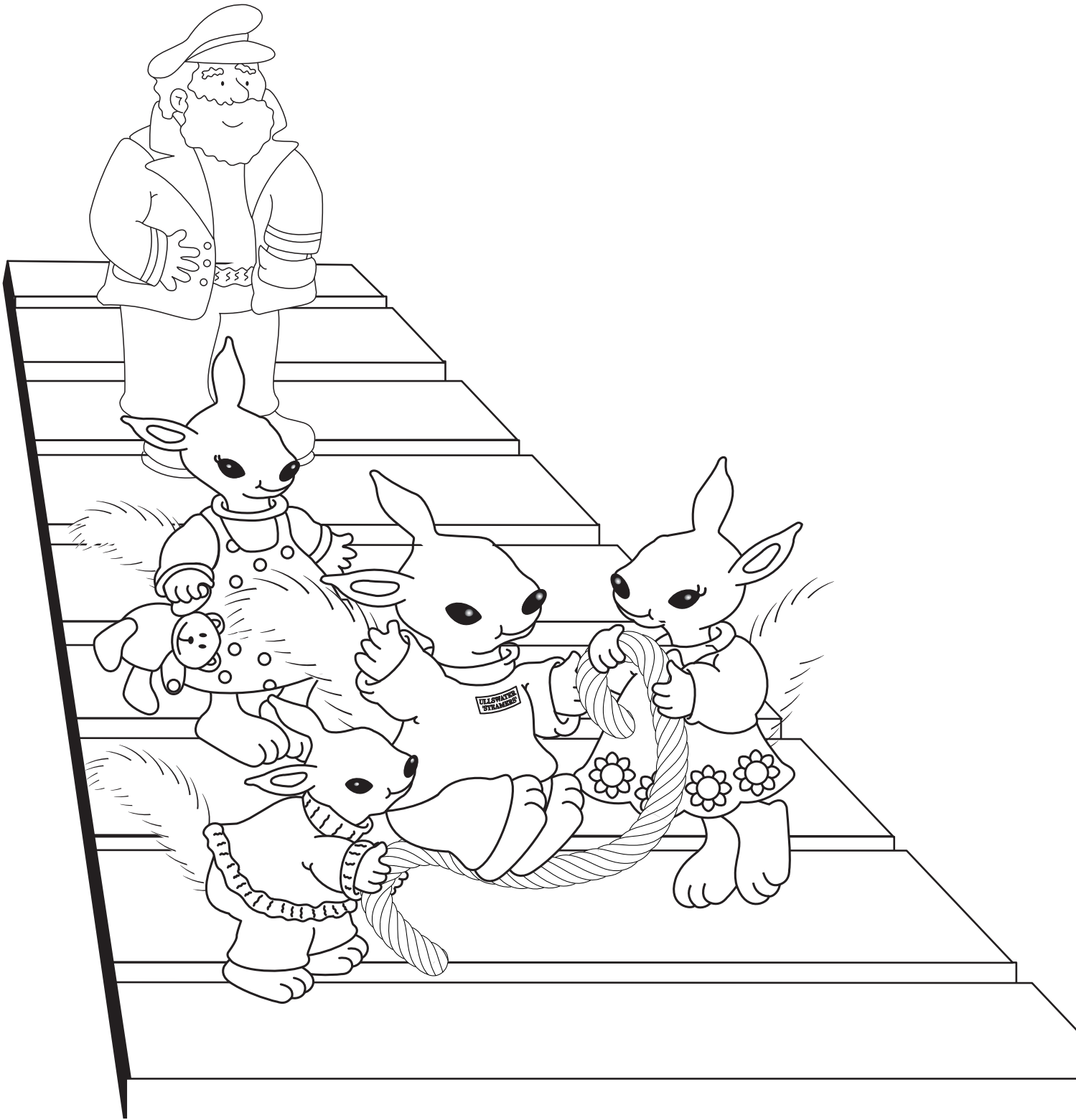

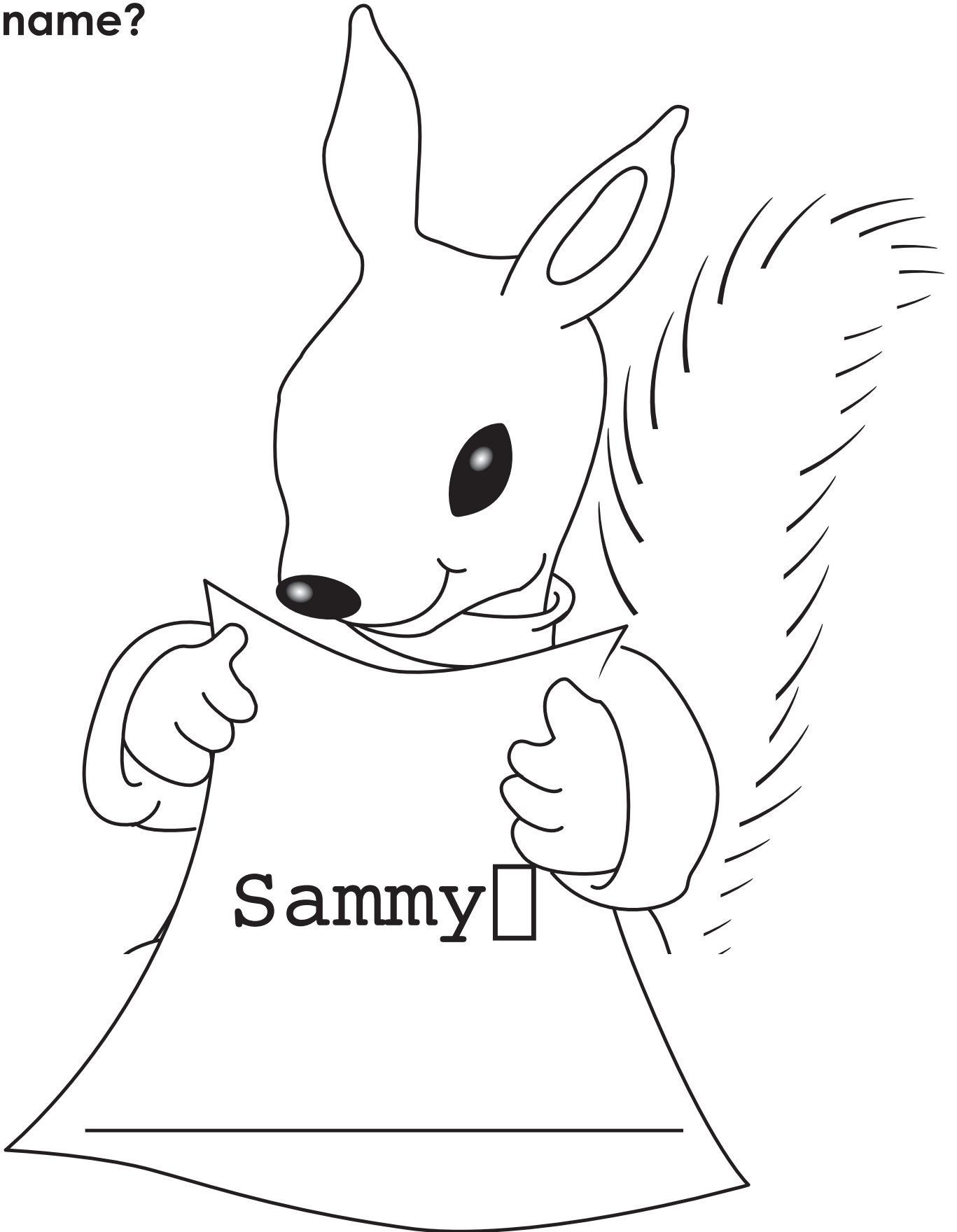

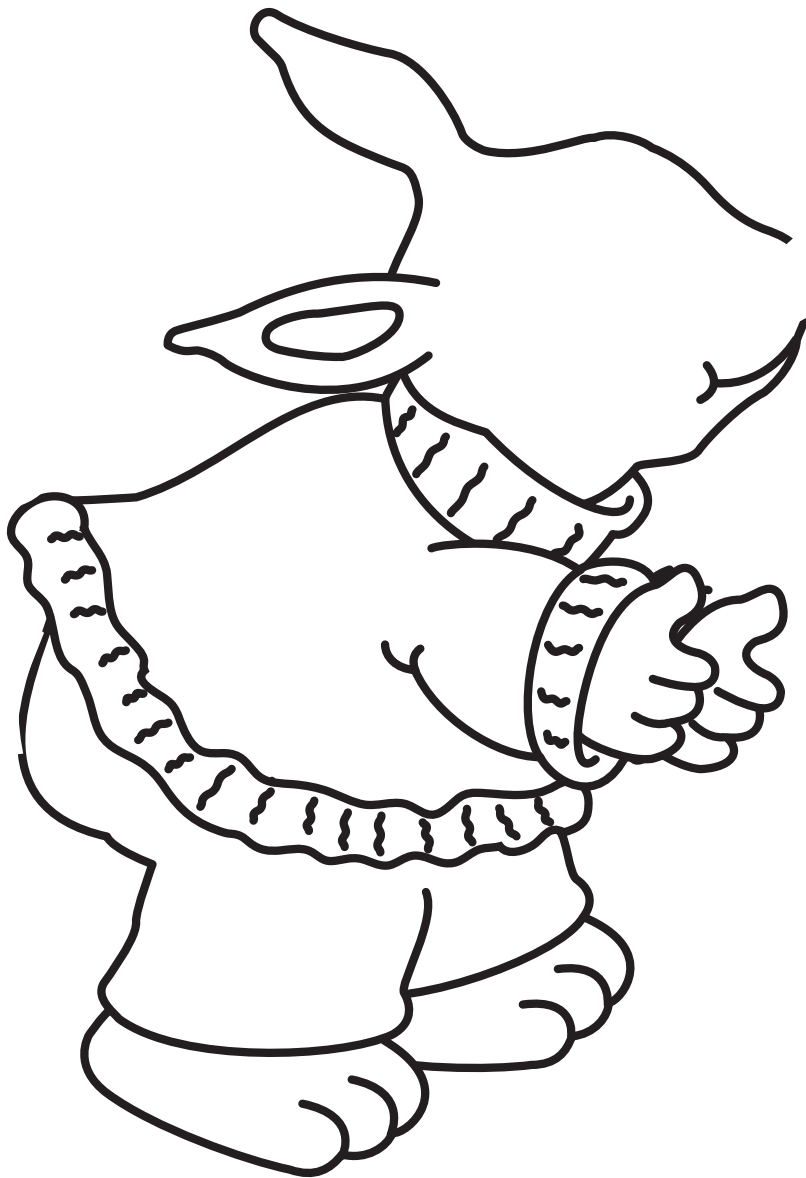


Sammy has written his name on the sheet of paper in front of him. Can you copy his name?



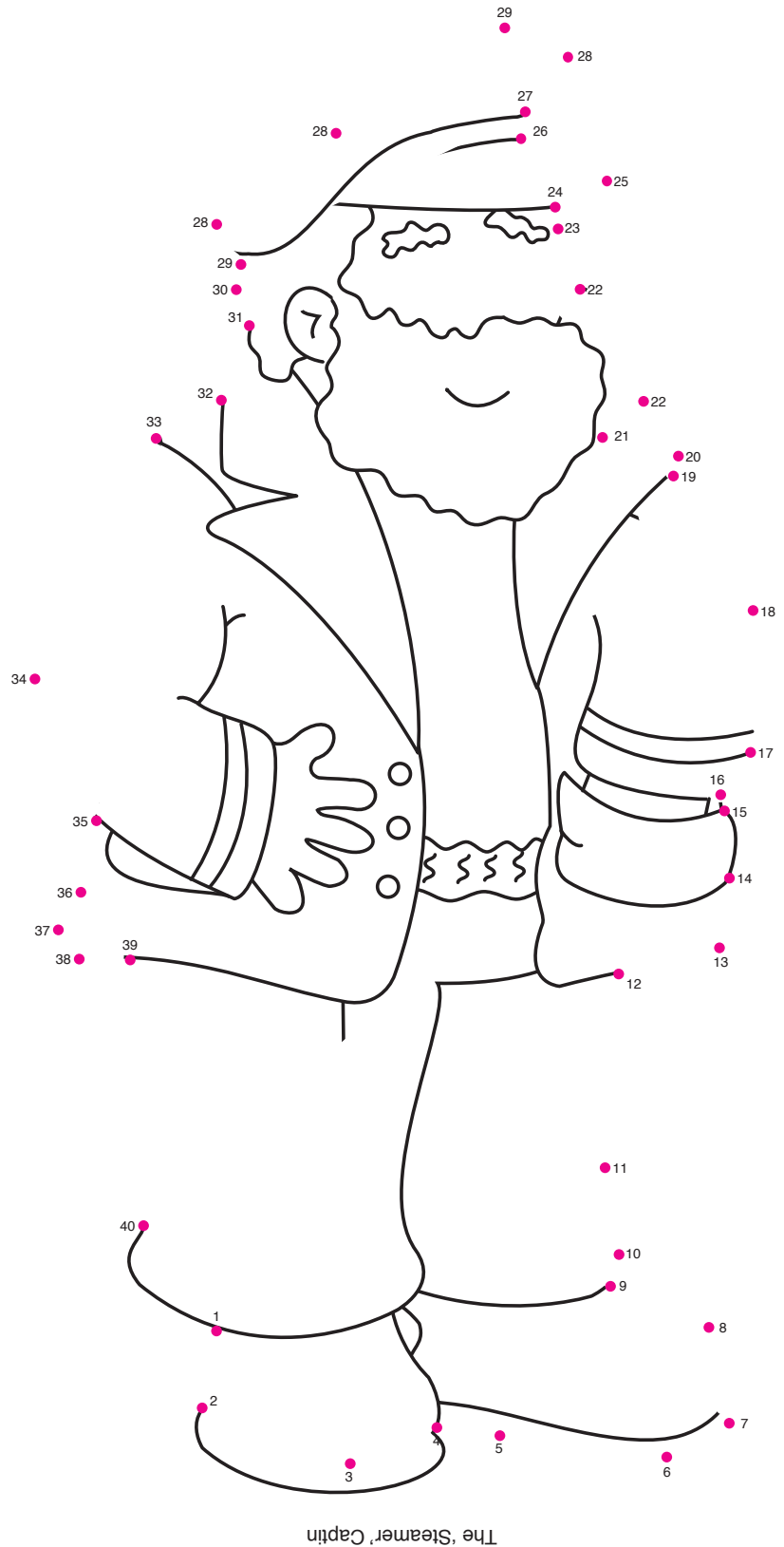
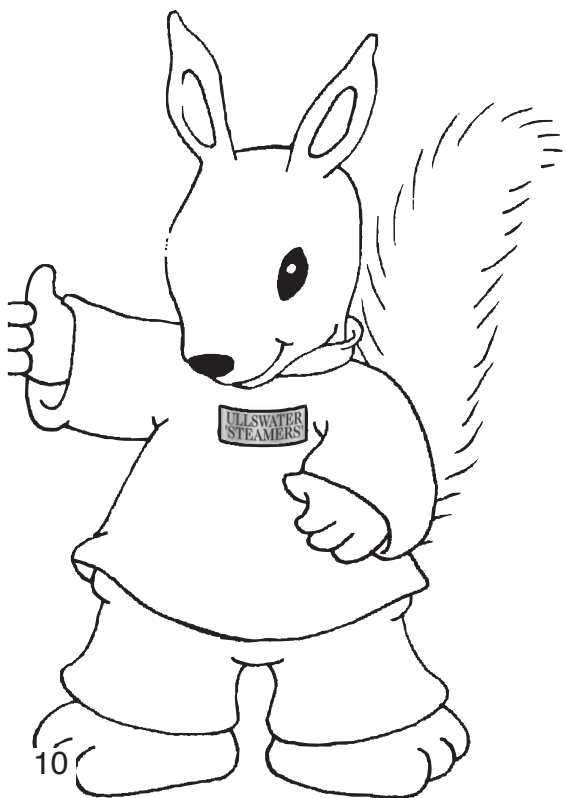
Here is Sidney. Draw his eyes his nose and a big smiley mouth. Then add a big, bushy tail.

Now colour him in!



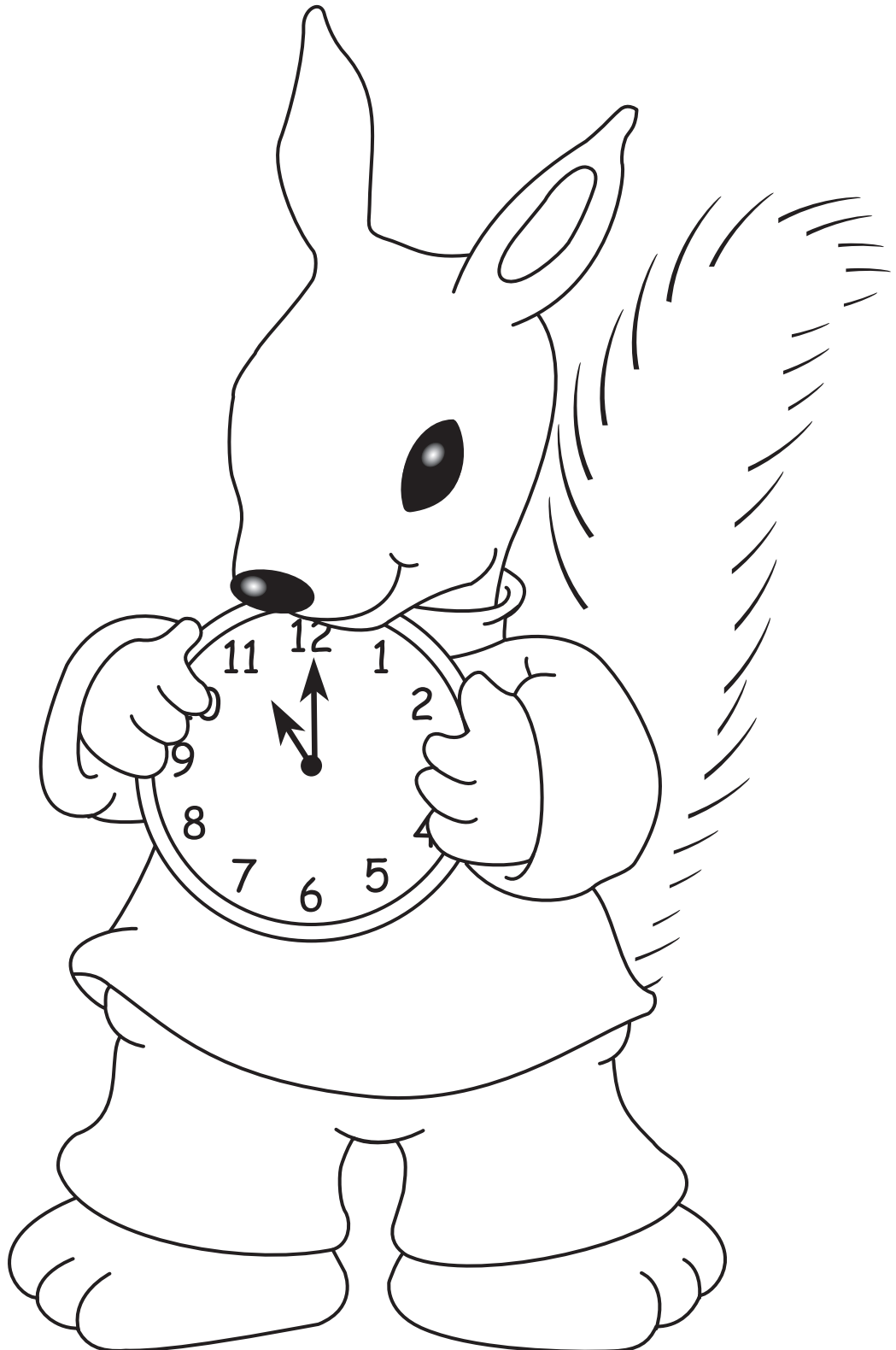
DOT TO DOT

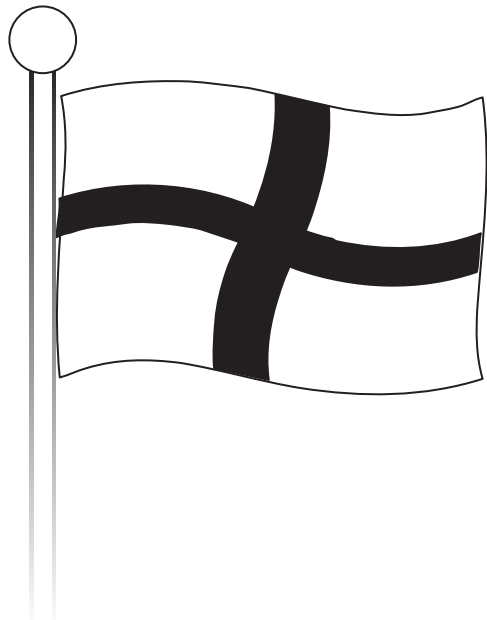


The Steamer' Captain

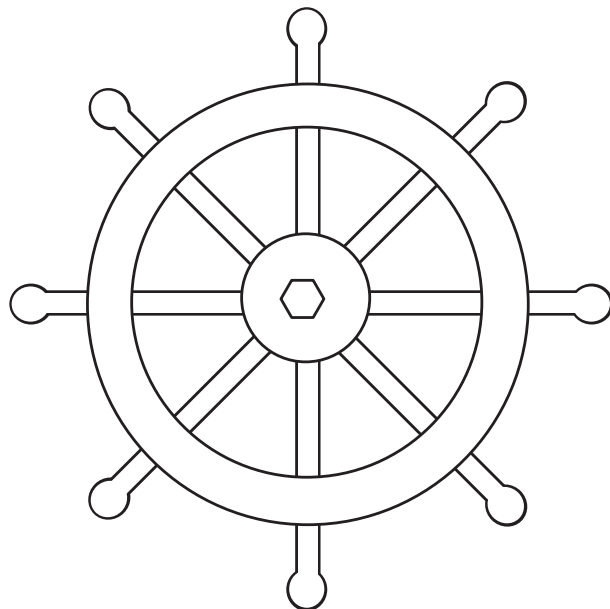
Sammy Squirrel says the 'Steamer' sets off when the little hand is at eleven and the big hand is at twelve. What time is it?



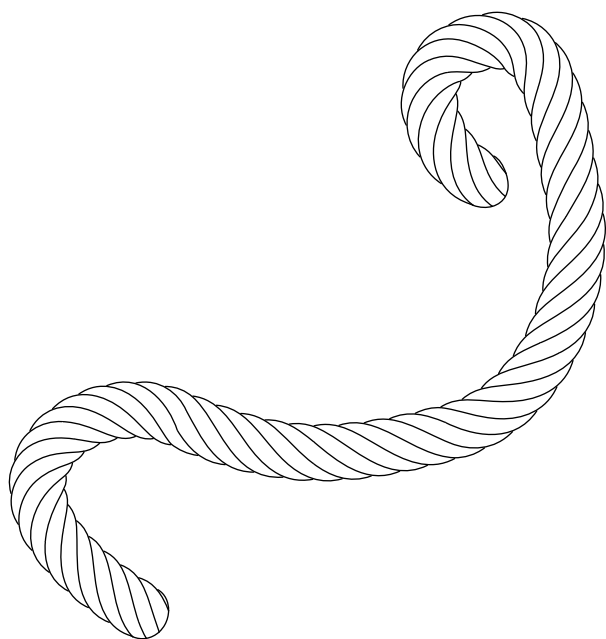
Which of these did you see when you sailed on the 'steamer'? Tick the box by the object if you saw it!



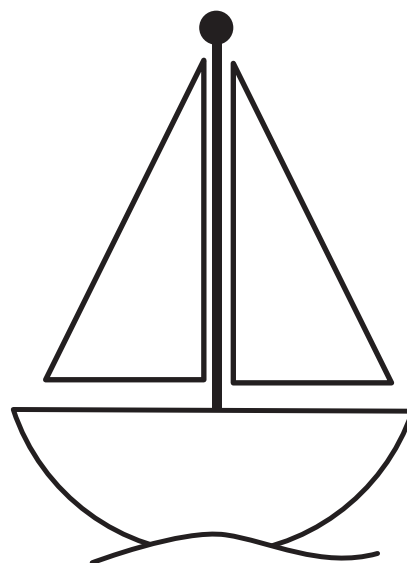
A Flag
