

Getting Here

Signed on the M6 Motorway and from Junction 40 to the attraction.

Travel times from key destination

Glasgow & Edinburgh roughly 110 miles. Drive time approx. 2 hours. Take M6 J40, follow A66 to Rheged and then take the A592 to Ullswater. Train time approx. 2 hours. West Coast Mainline services direct to Penrith. Stagecoach bus connections from the station.



Take A1(M) north from York, join A66 to Rheged and then take the A592 to Ullswater. Train time approx. 3 hours. Transpennine Express service to Manchester Piccadilly and change for services to Penrith. Stagecoach bus connections from the station.

Manchester & Liverpool roughly 100 miles. Drive time approx. 2 hours. Take M6 J40, follow A66 to Rheged and then take the A592 to Ullswater. Alternatively take M6 J36, follow A590, A591 and A592 to Ullswater. Train time approx. 2 hours. Northern Rail service to Preston and change for Virgin services to Penrith. Stagecoach bus connections from the station.

London roughly 300 miles. Drive time approx. 5 hours 30 minutes. Take M6 J40, follow A66 to Rheged and then take the A592 to Ullswater. Train time approx. 3 hours. Direct West Coast Mainline services from London Euston to Penrith. Stagecoach bus connections from the station.













- Please confirm your group numbers seven days prior to visit.
